

.22 Bench Rest Matches

Sponsored by the non-profit shooting club, the EE DA HOW Rifle & Pistol Club.

A 50-yard .22 benchrest match is held monthly at the Black's Creek Range (BCR) located southeast of Boise. Shooters may shoot any .22 caliber rifle using .22 long rifle ammunition. Shooting is done from a bench using a sandbag rest or bipod. Any optic is allowed and the scope magnification should be high enough to see the holes in the paper target at 50 yards.

The match consists of 3 targets. Each target contains 25 record bulls and several sighter bulls. Shooters have 20 minutes to shoot 25 bulls at 50 yards with one shot per bull for a maximum score of 2500. Sighter bulls can be used anytime during the match.

The BCR benchrest matches are sanctioned by the American Rimfire Association (ARA). Shooters need an ARA ID to shoot in an ARA sanctioned match. Go to <https://www.americanrimfire.com/> and click on the link "I want to shoot ARA" on the left side of the page. There is a link to register online, and additional links to the match schedule and match results for each club. Shooters that come to the match without an ARA ID can complete a printed registration form on match day to get an ARA ID.

The matches are held at the BCR Schuetzen range on the third Saturday of the month from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m, with setup and registration beginning at 12:00. The match fee is \$10 for EE DA HOW club members and \$15 for non-members. See the 2024 match schedule below.
